## KIMBALL CENTER OFFERS HEATING ASSISTANCE



The Kimball Center wants to keep folks warm this winter and will be offering energy assistance grants to Kimball-area residents in need. One-time grants will be available to area citizens on a first-come first-served basis. The funding will be made directly to the energy supplier. Each household will be eligible for one grant only during the 2012 winter (February – April). Folks interested should stop in the Kimball Center on Main Street during business hours: Mondays 11a.m. – 2 p.m. and Fridays 3-6 p.m.

The Lads & Lassies 4-H Club is coordinating the American Cancer Society's annual 2012 Daffodil Days this year in Kimball. Daffodil orders will be taken through Friday, February 17<sup>th</sup> with Proceeds helping in the fight against cancer. Flowers will be delivered the first week in March, just in time for spring! To participate in Daffodil Days, donations can be made to receive beautiful daffodils or to share them with someone special. Order forms are available at both Kimball churches, or First Dakota Bank. Orders may also be phoned in to 4-H Leader Pam Geppert at 778-6227. Flower costs range in price from \$10 for a single bunch of daffodils to \$75 for the *Sunshine Bouquet*. ## USEFUL WINTER WEATHER LINKS

Here are two computer links that we can find useful in these times of uncertain weather conditions. The first is a link to the South Dakota Department of Transportation that shows the condition of roads. The camera icons can be clicked on to see a camera looking on the road in that area and the map can be zoomed in to show more detail by clicking on the plus sign in the area to the left or moving to a direction (E,W,N,S) on the < or > symbols. The second link is to the National Weather Service site and has information for a 7 day forecast for the immediate area of Kimball. You can change locations to see other forecasts by typing a zip code in the blanks near the top. This site is also updated during the day as is warranted by conditions.
