KIMBALL CENTER UPDATE



The Kimball Center continues to provide critical resources to the people of Kimball and the surrounding area. The Kimball Center is staffed by volunteers every **Monday from 11 a.m. through 2 p.m. and Friday from 3-6 p.m.** Resources available at the K Center include canned & boxed food, toiletries and cleaning supplies. A limited supply of children's hats & gloves, dishes and toasters are also on hand. All withdrawals from the K Center are completely confidential.

Over the past year, the Kimball Center has served about a dozen families in the area. Home deliveries are available upon request. Cash donations to the Kimball Center are always welcome. The food pantry is also seeking donations of: laundry soap & softener, garbage bags, diapers, home cleaning supplies, pasta, pasta sauce, cereal, pancake mix & syrup. Thanks to earlier generosity the center does **not** need canned soup or vegetables. The K Center does not accept clothing, computer equipment or furniture, however is willing to keep a list of available items upon request. Future programs for the Kimball Center include energy assistance grants and a Christmas gift program. The energy assistance program will become available after the first of the year. Nutritious and balanced meals are offered each weekday (no weekends or holiday meals) at Kimball Senior Center on main street. Persons over 60 years of age (and their spouses even if younger) are eligible to receive meals at a reduced cost. Those under 60 would pay the full cost to prepare the meal. Meals are also available to be delivered to the residence of those who are homebound or have difficulty in traveling to the center. Meal tickets can be purchased by those eating at the center or purchased by others as a gift to those eating at the Center About 28 people are served each day at the Center. Mrs. Miller, who also serves at head cook, encourages others in the community to take advantage of this opportunity. Not only will those participating be served a balanced meal but would enjoy the social interaction with others in attendance.

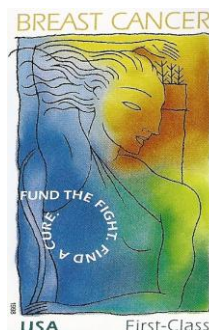
